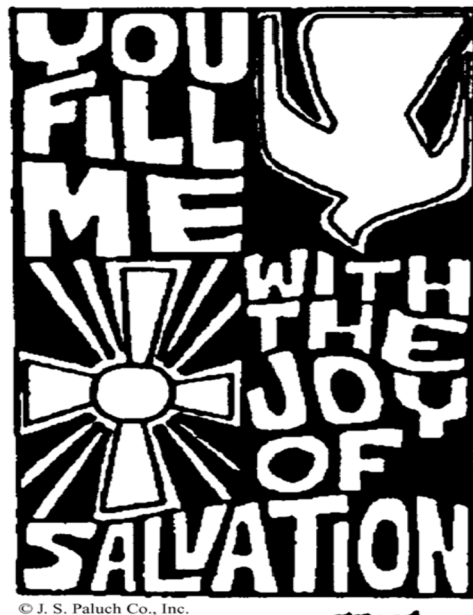

A reminder of the rules of ***Fast and Abstinence*** as we approach the holy season of Lent.

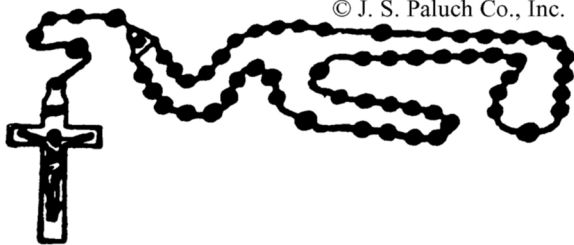
ABSTINENCE from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent (for those 14 and older) is required by Church Law. Additionally, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are **fast days**, those between the ages of 18 and 59, should eat less, taking no solid food between meals and consuming only one full meal that day. Serious reasons such as one's health can excuse a person from these rules. Pastors and parents are

encouraged by the law of the Church to see to it that minors who are not bound by the laws of **FAST AND ABSTINENCE** are educated in the authentic sense of penance. Following the implementation of the revised *Code of Canon Law* on November 27, 1983, the National Conference of Catholic Bishops in the United States determined that the rules of fast and abstinence which have existed for the last several years in this country be maintained. **Namely, that the faithful observe suitable penitential practices on all Fridays throughout the year.** These penitential practices need not include abstaining from meat. However, as indicated above, the faithful must not eat meat on all Fridays of Lent as well as on Ash Wednesday. They must also observe faithfully the fast regulations as they have been stated above in accord with the universal law of the Church.

ASH WEDNESDAY

Mass will be celebrated at 12:05 pm at Holy Angels in Barrington and 7:00 pm at Saint Alexander in Warren on Ash Wednesday, February 17. Ashes will be distributed at both Masses.
